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**ORDER GRANTING MOTION REQUESTING THE SETTING OF A CLAIMS FILING  
DEADLINE AND GRANTING RELATED RELIEF**

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Currently before the Court is Barbara D. Richardson’s (the “Commissioner”), Commissioner of Insurance in her capacity as Permanent Receiver of Physicians Indemnity Risk Retention Group, Inc., *Motion Requesting the Setting of a Claims Filing Deadline and Granting Related Relief* (“Motion”) filed and submitted to the Court for consideration on April 22, 2022. On April 29, 2022, this Court issued an *Order Vacating Submission* to allow the appropriate time for a response. The Commissioner resubmitted the Motion on May 16, 2022.<sup>1</sup>

1 Based upon the foregoing for good cause appearing,

2 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 3 1. The proposed Proof of Claim (“POC”) procedure described in the Motion, including  
4 the forms and instructions attached as Exhibits 1-3 to the Motion, are approved;
- 5 2. The proposed Receivership Appeal Procedure described in the Motion, including the  
6 forms and instructions attached as Exhibits 3 & 4 to the Motion, are approved.
- 7 3. Claim and appeal processing procedures substantially in the form as those described  
8 within and presented as Exhibits to the Motion comply with applicable Nevada law,  
9 and are within the authority granted to the Receiver by the Permanent Receivership  
10 Order and applicable Nevada law;
- 11 4. The proposed notice procedures described in the Motion are approved, and the Court  
12 finds that notice procedures in the same or substantially similar form comply with the  
13 requirements of Nevada law and due process (including the forms of notice attached  
14 as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 5 to the Motion);
- 15 5. **December 1, 2022**, is established as the deadline (the “Claims Filing Deadline”) for  
16 filing and rendering absolute, non-contingent, and liquidated in amount, claims against  
17 PIRRG;
- 18 6. This Claiming Filing Deadline applies equally to any tail coverage claims unless the  
19 actual end of tail coverage under the individual policy occurs first;
- 20 7. All claims against PIRRG not postmarked on or before the Claims Filing Deadline and  
21 received at the address specified by the Receiver will be deemed not timely filed and  
22 shall be barred, not subject to processing by the Receiver, and ineligible to share in  
23 any distribution of the assets of the estate – PIRRG shall have no liabilities as to any  
24 such late-filed claims;
- 25 8. Claims which have not been rendered absolute (*i.e.*, both liquidated in amount and  
26 non-contingent) on or before the Claims Filing Deadline may not share in the assets  
27 of the receivership estate (subject to any applicable exceptions found in NRS  
28 696B.450, which will be in the Receiver’s sole discretion to determine);

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9. All other relief requested by the Motion is hereby granted; and  
10. This Order is designated as a Final Order pursuant to NRS 696B.190(5).  
IT IS SO ORDERED.


